# SPRING REMINDERS!!

## Noise Bylaw

1. (a) Except to the extent it is allowed to this Bylaw no person shall make, or continue to make, or cause to be made, or allow to be made, or allow to be continued to be made, any loud noise, or any unnecessary noise, or any unusual noise.  
  
(b) Except to the extent it is allowed by this Bylaw, no person shall make, or continue to make, or cause to be made or cause to be continued, or allow to be made, or allow to be continued, any noise whatsoever which either annoys, disturbs, injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons within the limits of the municipality.  
  
(c) What is a loud noise, an unnecessary noise, an unusual noise, or a noise which annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons is a question of fact for a court which hears a prosecution of an offence against this Bylaw.
2. Without restricting the generality of Section 3, no person shall operate or allow to be operated a lawn mower of any kind, rototiller, or a model aircraft driven by an internal combustion engine in any within 500 feet of an inhabited building within the residential district between the hours of:  
  
(a) 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. on weekdays; and  
(b) 10:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on weekends or public holidays;
3. No person who owns, keeps, houses, harbours or allows to stay in his premises a dog shall allow such a dog to bark or howl excessively.
4. No person being the owner or occupant of any premises shall operate, or permit to be operated, or suffer to be operated, or allow to be operated, play or allow to be played, a radio, phonograph, record-player, tape recorded, television set, musical instrument, or any other apparatus, appliance, device or machine used for the production or amplification of sound, either in or on private premises in a residential district in such a manner that the same can be easily heard by an individual or member of the public who is not on the same premises from which such noise or sound emanates.

## Animal Bylaws

1. No person shall herd even-toed hoofed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry, rodents, fur bearing animals within the limits of the Municipality.
2. No person shall graze even-toed hoofed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry, rodents, fur bearing animals at any time within the limits of the Municipality.
3. No person shall keep even-toed hoofed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry, kennels for dogs, catteries, rodents, ratteries, fur farms or doves at any time within the limits of the Municipality.
4. No person shall keep more than two (2) dogs or cats within the limits of the Municipality except for registered dogs and cats used for breeding purposes.
5. No dog should run at large in the municipality.
6. A person who owns, possesses, or harbours a dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of Bylaw No. 1 of 1990.

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## BYLAW ENFORCEMENT

- Public Notice is hereby given to inform the citizens of the Village of Liberty and area that the Village has hired the Commissionaires South Saskatchewan to enforce the following Bylaws for the Village of Liberty:

02-2006 – Nuisance Bylaw                      01-1992 – Noise Bylaw                      01-1990 – Animal Bylaw  
06-2016 – Ownership of Animals Bylaw                      04-2020 – Traffic Bylaw

The contract will commence May 1, 2023 for a period of four months to September 30, 2023.

The Commissionaires will be easily identifiable as they will be wearing uniforms and driving identifiable decaled vehicles. The Commissionaires will have full authority to enforce the bylaws of the Village of Liberty.

Although the Commissionaires purpose will be to enforce our bylaws, the initial period will be more education than enforcement.

Citizens of our Village will be given ample opportunity to comply with the Village Bylaws; however, compliance with our bylaws will be required. **Copies of these Bylaws are available at our office, Post Office and on the website.** Failure to comply with bylaws could result in further action taking place including such steps as issuing an "Order to Remedy," fines, and compliance completed by the Village with the costs being charged to the bylaw offender.

The Commissionaires are being hired to serve the citizens of the Village of Liberty so please treat them with respect.

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## **NEW WATER RATES BYLAW IN PROGRESS..**

**The new water/sewer rates will be in effect upon approval by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board and will be as follows:**

### Quarterly Water Rates:
