

# DO NOT DRINK NOTICE

## **Hygienic Water Use System**



This Notice applies to all residents and users of the **VILLAGE OF LIBERTY WATERWORKS SYSTEM**, is issued under section 32 (1) of The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2002 and is effective: January 1, 2005.

This Do Not Drink Notice is issued due to the drinking water system being classified as a “hygienic water use system” and we cannot ensure the safety of the water in the distribution system. Saskatchewan Environment and the Village of Liberty are reminding all consumers to

### **NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR:**

- (a) Drinking or ingesting in any manner;
- (b) Brushing teeth or soaking false teeth;
- (c) Dishwashing, unless sanitized in another fashion;
- (d) Washing fruits and vegetables;
- (e) Food or drink which will not be subsequently heated; and
- (f) Ice cubes

Under most circumstances, the water may be used for other household purposes. Adults, adolescents and older children may shower, bathe or wash up using tap water but should avoid swallowing the water. Laundry may be washed in tap water, either by hand or by machine. Younger children and infants must be sponge bathed to ensure they do not consume water during bathing.

Potable water is available at the Village of Liberty Fire Hall.
